



Fire Permits are required between April 1st and October 31st. However, they are not required between November 1st and March 31st. The fire permits are available at the municipal office during regular office hours. You must follow all instructions on your fire permits. **DO NOT BURN DURING THE DAY.** The permit is not valid between 2 hours after sunrise and 2 hours before sunset on any day. Winds shall not exceed 5km per hour. If you don't follow the terms and conditions of your permit, you could be charged by the MNR and upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of up to \$1,000.00 exclusive of costs. You must phone the New Liskeard Fire Department Office at 647-6360 before starting to burn.



A fire permit is not required for heating or cooking.



If there is a fire restriction by MNR in the area, no burning is permitted and no permits will be issued.

NOTE: PLASTIC AND PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE BURNED.
