

TOWNSHIPS OF HUDSON AND KERNS

LANDFILL SITE CARD PROGRAM

The Townships of Hudson and Kerns have been sharing the cost of the Hudson Landfill Site, located at 7040 Road C, for many years. The landfill site needs to be managed properly to expand the life expectancy of it. The cost of opening a new landfill site is very expensive. As per our records, we have approximately 18 years left of unused space.

Last year, the Townships of Hudson and Kerns agreed to proceed towards a user pay system in implementing a bag tag program to control the quantity of garbage entering our landfill site. Every household was limited to 2 garbage bags per week.

For 2017, the Townships of Hudson and Kerns have agreed to proceed with a new system for the garbage bags. Each resident will be handed a laminated blue card with numbers from 1 to 104. Every time you bring garbage to the landfill site, the dump supervisor will punch in the number of bags you are bringing. If your card is used up before the end of the year, you will be able to purchase an additional \$20.00 card, which would enable you to bring another 10 bags.

Only the Garbage generated from the households from the Townships of Hudson and Kerns will be allowed to be disposed of at the landfill site.

BLUE CARD PICK-UP: Your free BLUE CARD can be picked up at the Hudson Outreach Library during their operating hours. Hours for the Library are Wednesday 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Saturday 11:00 am to 3:00 pm.

FEES FOR AN ADDITIONAL CARD: \$ 20.00 per card

All additional \$20.00 cards will have to be picked-up at the Township Office at 903303 Hanbury Road, during regular office hours (Monday to Friday: 8:00 am to 4:00 pm).

ADDITIONAL TIPPING FEES:

- Non-hazardous Waste: Pick-up truck	\$10.00
- Non-hazardous Waste: Pick-up truck & trailer	\$20.00
- Non-hazardous Waste: Single axle dump truck	\$30.00
- Non-hazardous Waste: Tandem truck	\$60.00
- Non-hazardous Waste: Tri-axle truck	\$75.00
- Contaminated Waste: per cubic yard	\$30.00
- Tires - Passenger, light truck	N/C
- Tires - Trucks - 35 to 48 inches	\$25.00
- Tires - Com/Ind Oversized 49 to 60 inches	\$150.00

*** All tires larger than 60 inches are banned from the landfill site

*** Tires still on rims are also banned from the landfill site

*** A 45 gal drum full is worth 3 punches on your card

EXEMPTION: The Committee agrees to remove the Dump Tipping Fees for brush when the rate payer is doing property maintenance. Land clearing will have a Dump Tipping Fee as per described in the **ADDITIONAL TIPPING FEES SCHEDULE ABOVE**.

The Committee strongly encourage recycling. There are no fees for the recyclables. Recyclable are to be disposed in the bins provided at the landfill site. If possible gather your recyclables in a transparent plastic bag, or if they are in a dark plastic bag, you need to open the bag and discard the recycling in the bin provided.

COMPOSTABLE WASTE DEFINITION: Compostable materials, such as lawn clippings, garden waste, leaves, flowers, plants, fruits and vegetables, brought to the landfill site will have to pay the required tipping fees, as per described in the **ADDITIONAL TIPPING FEES SCHEDULE ABOVE**.

FEES COLLECTED: The Dump Supervisor has the final decision on the quantity brought to the landfill site and will determine the quantity of ties required, or the fee to be charge.

The Dump Supervisor will be collecting fees (**cash only**), and will provide the user with a receipt. Businesses will have the opportunity to open a charge account with the Municipality; they will be invoiced monthly including an administration charge of \$10.00.
