WHEREAS, preliminary data for 2020 in Timiskaming reports 12 overdose cases having presented to hospital emergency rooms, with overdoses being treated at home, and not reported: and

WHEREAS, we affirm that the people affected by overdose are our sons and daughters, our mothers and fathers, our brothers and sisters, and deserving of our love, compassion and support; they are not people like us,-they are us;

THEREFORE, the Township of Harley, on behalf of the citizens do hereby proclaim August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 as Overdose Awareness Day, and call upon all citizens to renew their commitment to be educated on the impact of overdose and join in working for its awareness and prevention within our community.
