a. Harley Fire Department Arren Hearn – Deputy Fire Chief Chris Lemire – Volunteer Firefighter

Arren Hearn is currently working at a remote location that requires a two-week rotation. Chris Lemire also works at a remote location, but his rotation is 4 days on and 10 days off. Between Arren and Chris, one of the two will always attend fire department meetings. During times when both Arren and Chris' schedules overlap, they will rely on their two captains, Roger Donck and Logan Miron. During a situation where the township needs to contact the fire department and both Arren and Chris are at work, Arren will be available by email in the evenings and Chris will be available by phone or email.

Both Arren and Chris plan to have vehicles inspected weekly. Inspections will be split between Arren, Chris, Roger and Logan. A better paper trail will also be implemented for tracking vehicle inspections and vehicle safety inspections.

Firefighters that do not regularly attend meetings and trainings are a liability to themselves and others while responding to calls. Both Arren and Chris have already spoken to several volunteer firefighters with poor attendance to correct the situation. The fire department has also made online training available. So far attendance is back up.
