That the Provincial and Federal Governments work with Canadian universities to increase the number of students accepted into medical school and residency programs; and

That the Province expedites the accreditation process for foreign medical practitioners; and

That the Township of Harley supports whatever protective measures the Provincial and Federal Governments place on the subsidy given to ensure that the students receiving the funding become practicing physicians in the Province of Ontario; and

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That a letter of support be forwarded to the Town of South Bruce Peninsula along with Premier Doug Ford.
